	<p>Expressions: Reaction 【Good news】 Awesome! / Lucky you! / That's great! / That's nice! 【Bad News】 I'm sorry to hear that. / Oh, no! / That's terrible! /That's too bad. 【Surprising News】 No way! /Really? /That's crazy! / You're joking! 【Everyday News】 I see. / Oh, yeah? /OK. /Uh-huh.</p>
