【1】 Greeting & introduction: 5 mins

- ✓ Ask the questions listed below, and check if the students answer with reason, frequency, opinion, or question. (See Practice on p. 33.)
- ✓ To questions (A)-(H), the students are expected to answer you without much difficulty, for they have practiced them in the homework. (I)-(L) are new ones.

(A) Do you have any pets?

(B) Do you like karaoke?

(C) Do you prefer tea or coffee?

(D) Do you like studying English?

(E) What kind of music do you like?

(F) What sports do you like?

(G) How many people are there in your family?

(H) Which country would you like to visit?

(I) What club do you belong to? Are you a member of any club activity?

(J) What game do you like?

(K) Where do you work?

(L) How many classes do you have in a week?

【3】 Practice conversation: 10 mins

Model: Words in red are the parts both the teacher and the students must fill in.
