Question & Answer Example:								
Filipino teacher: What is number 1 like?								
Student: It is artistic.								
FT: What is number 2 like?								
S: It is easygoing.								
[3] Practice Conversation: Giving examples								
$\checkmark$ Talk about the personality of yours and the students.								
✓ First you talk about your personality and ask for an example.								
$\checkmark$ Second let the student talk about his/her personality and example.								
Example:								
FT: I am artistic. For example, what do I like?								
S: For example, you like drawing pictures.								
FT: What are you like?								
S: I am funny. I am good at telling jokes.
