### 【1】 Greeting & introduction [5 mins]

It's getting warmer and warmer: around the end of June, it was around 30 degrees in Sapporo, which is unusual in the northern part of Japan. #### Question & Answer Example:

Filipino teacher: What is the correct expression for number 1?

Student: Hang out at my house.

FT: What is the correct expression for number 2?

S: Play a basketball game.    Go to a basketball game.

S: OK, I'm free. How about going **shopping**?

FT: That's a nice idea. Then we could go for **dinner** if you like.

S: Yeah. Where shall we go?

FT: We could go to Susukino.

S: Sounds good. Why don't we meet at 8 p.m.?

FT: Perfect. So, let's meet at 8 p.m.

S: Great. I'm looking forward to it!

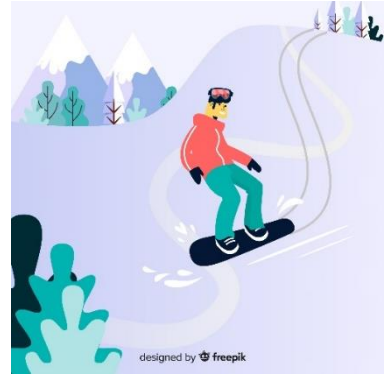
