	Similarly, it may be difficult to share your experiences if they ask
	you what your plans are for (for example) "after teaching".
	Use the idea of New Year's resolution to swap stories, then focus
	on them practicing future tense. Question time can be anything,
	since this is likely the last time they will see you. Example plan
	below

	- Play a simple game of "what's missing?" Show images of
	future plans once. Then the next time you share the
	image/slide/document some parts have been removed, and
	they have to remember which.
	- Ask which of the plans in the images they would like to do /
	plan to do.
	- Elicit easy steps for a big long-term goal. Give one example

like "My friend would like to be healthier. So he will...

a. eat in fancy restaurants <u>b. not stay up late at night</u> c.go on holiday

My friend would like to be rich. So she will...

My family member would like to be a YouTuber. So he will...

My student would like to get a TOEIC score of 900. So he will...
