Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Talk about routines.</li> <li>• Describe frequency.</li> </ul>
Key Questions / Words / Phrases	<p>Warm up by inviting students to introduce themselves.</p> <p>What do (usually) you do...?          How often do you...?          Do you...? + topics on P.16(A) and P.20(C), or more.</p> <p>Daily / Weekend Activities (P.16(A).20(C))</p>
Special Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be aware of turn-taking issue. Please kindly give each student equal amount of time if possible.</li> <li>• Encourage your students to talk more by giving them simple closed-ended questions. For high-level students, open-ended questions will be fine.</li> <li>• Start from something simple, but gradually challenge them with follow-up questions. For example. What is your major? --&gt; Why did you choose this major?</li> <li>• If you ask the same question by rephrasing it too much, you may confuse your students even more. Sometimes giving them sample answers is the best approach.</li> <li>• Assess student's level, and please talk slowly when necessary.</li> <li>• Avoid using difficult words if their level is low. Also try not to explain complicated word definition.</li> <li>• Make sure your students ask you questions too!</li> <li>• Please avoid too much correction of grammar mistakes. If the sentence is comprehensible, then let the conversation flow.</li> </ul>

Additionally, students may ask you 3 general questions e.g. What sport do you like?
