Special Notes (optional)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Share screen wherever possible.</li> <li>• As this is the final FT session of the semester, feel free to push them and ask more follow-up questions.</li> <li>• <b>Ensure</b> there is 10 minutes at the end for their questions to teachers.</li> </ul> <p>Sample lesson flow is below.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Brief warm-up small talk questions.</li> <li>- Ask if they plan to <b>go out</b> this weekend. If they will <b>hang out</b> with friends and where.</li> <li>- <u>Brief practice</u> arranging schedules using pp.69-70 Activity B. "Okay, ...san, are you free this Sunday morning? Ah I see. How about..."</li> <li>- Do the model conversation on p.68. Discuss what kind of place Alice &amp; June decided to go to. "Right,</li> </ul>

shopping mall. Do you like shopping malls? How often do you go?"

- Randomise questions from p.67. Ask them why they like activities they "usually" do, why they dislike things they "never" do. And use exaggerated body language to ask them what they would do on a date. This question should get the most laughs.
- Do 'would you rather' with different places. For Tourism 3 it could just be typical Japanese places (karaoke, bowling, game centre, shrine etc.) but for Jinbun 1 and Sports 1, add typical Filipino spots to the mix.
- **Show & tell**. All students should have prepared a picture, and some sentences based on p.71. The order is up to you, but it would be good if you swapped pictures, so please prepare 1 picture and a short talk also.
- **\*\*\*Show and tell is the main part, so please give it more time than a) arranging schedules or b) small talk on p.67\*\*\***
