Title	Opinions
Target Sentence Pattern	<p>I do not want to limit students to a certain sentence pattern, or to correct use of English. I want them to focus only on communication – whether they can get you to understand what they want to convey.</p> <p>Grammar feedback will be done at the end of the class, after the Zoom session.</p>
Key Objectives / Questions / Expressions	<p>I have two tasks I would like students to complete during this Zoom session.</p> <p>Task 1: Students will interview teachers about their opinions in the form of “Which is more ____, A or B?”. When you answer, I’d like you to give a reason for your answer. Students will circle your answer and then make a note of your reason. Once students appear to be done, please ask the question back to them. If they give a reason, make a comment on it. If they don’t give a reason, please try to encourage one by waiting longer than usual before asking follow-up questions, or by responding with just “oh”, or “yeah?” to indicate that you want to hear more without immediately supporting the student.</p> <p>Task 2: I have asked students to prepare answers to the four questions on page 117C. Please ask each student each of the questions, make comments on their answer and ask follow-up questions if students’ level seems high enough.</p> <p>Once the two tasks are finished, you can ask students for their opinions on other simple topics, starting with “Which is more ____, A or B?” and branching out if appropriate.</p>
