Title	Going Out
Target Sentence Pattern	I do not want to limit students to a certain sentence pattern, or to correct use of English. I want them to focus only on communication – whether they can get you to understand what they want to convey. Grammar feedback will be done at the end of the class, after the Zoom session.
Key Objectives / Questions / Expressions	After briefly making small talk with students, students will have two tasks to complete. Task 1: Find five activities that all members would enjoy doing with friends (teacher + 2-3 students). We used the following list of activities to discuss this in class: do cooking go cycling go out to eat go for a drive go for a walk go see a movie go shopping go to a café go to a festival go to a live concert go to a park go to the aquarium go to the beach/ocean go to the zoo go travelling gossip have a home date have a study date play baseball play card/board games play sports play video games row a swan boat see the sunset sing karaoke study English talk about random stuff talk about travel go hiking go to an amusement park Task 2: Students have been asked to prepare a schedule of their daily life. Match your own schedule to students’ schedules and make a plan to hang out in virtual reality together doing some of the activities listed above. Plans should include what day and time, what activity, and a little detail about how you would do it. For example, if you decide to watch a movie together in virtual reality, you could choose which movie. After both tasks are complete, you can talk more freely about students’ schedules or the things they like to do in their free time.
